## PARKING ORDINANCE

*The Police Department will be taking second looks at violators of the following Village Ordinances:*

- **7-4-1: PARKING PLACES**  
*Among the many places where it is unlawful to stand or park unless to avoid conflict with other traffic or by direction of a police officer or traffic control device, Listed are a few violations that will be enforced:*  
In any intersection; In a crosswalk; Upon any bridge or in a viaduct or in any subway or tunnel or the approach thereto; Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant; Within 50 feet of the nearest rail of a railroad grade crossing; On any sidewalk or parkway, and anyplace where official signs prohibit parking.
- **7-4-2: PARKING RESTRICTIONS**  
*Parking at curbs and Angle Parking. Peddling. Sale of Vehicle(s) Trailers. All-Night Parking on any street is prohibited with restrictions. All-Night Parking in a Municipal Lot and after a snowfall has conditions and restrictions. Front yard parking is prohibited. Parking in a Handicapped space without a current sticker or plate.*
