### PARKING ORDINANCE

The Police Department will be taking second looks at violators of the following Village Ordinances:

### 7-4-1: PARKING PLACES

Among the many places where it is unlawful to stand or park unless to avoid conflict with other traffic or by direction of a police officer or traffic control device, Listed are a few violations that will be enforced:

In any intersection; In a crosswalk; Upon any bridge or in a viaduct or in any subway or tunnel or the approach thereto; Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant; Within 50 feet of the nearest rail of a railroad grade crossing; On any sidewalk or parkway, and anyplace where official signs prohibit parking.

### 7-4-2: PARKING RESTRICTIONS

Parking at curbs and Angle Parking. Peddling. Sale of Vehicle(s) Trailers. All-Night Parking on any street is prohibited with restrictions. All-Night Parking in a Municipal Lot and after a snowfall has conditions and restrictions. Front yard parking is prohibited. Parking in a Handicapped space without a current sticker or plate.

- Replacement of water meters continues.
- Weather permitting, the Sweeper is on the street.
- Roosevelt Road, 17th Avenue, and the Municipal parking Lots are being cleaned. We need the public to help out by reporting those who litter.
- Avenue & Street Signs are being repaired and replaced. We need the public to help us identify those signs in need of repair or replacement.
- Pot Holes are being filled on a daily basis. We need the public to report on locations to be attended to.
- The Forestry Crew has removed all diseased trees that were topped out. Grinding stumps is underway.
- Chipping and branch pick-up will not begin until the first Monday of April.
- The Village of Broadview is once again designated as, "Tree City U.S.A." Our 3rd award will be given March 28, 2006 at the annual Tree City USA Confer.
- Residents who notice wet spots on the parkways or water running down the curb line should call the PW office immediately. It may indicate a water leak.
